Decision (Action Agreed)	<p>RESOLVED:</p> <p>That the Cabinet:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">Approve the addition of £68,000 to the Capital Programme to enable the purchase of pool car vehicles; andNote that the capital expenditure would be financed through MRP (Minimum Revenue Provision) over the 7 year anticipated life of the assets; Also facilitating future replacement in accordance with asset-life.
Reason(s)	The vehicles are no longer considered fit for purpose. Replacement vehicles are necessary to ensure staff can continue to undertake site visits, inspections and attend meetings.
Options	Do nothing – not recommended. The pool vehicles provide an important function to many services across the council, including planning building control, housing and environmental health in particular. The fleet is in need of

	renewal as the vehicles are in excess of 13 years old and all carry high mileage.
