It is adjudged that the complaint is true and under the provisions of Section 78 of the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act it is ordered that:-

1. It is required that you and any other persons with you are to leave the said land or remove any vehicle and other property which you have with you on the land.
2. The said Council by their officers and servants are hereby authorised to enter upon land at **Woodville Road Playing Field, Sleaford Road and Woodvile Road, Boston, PE21 8AN** and to take all such reasonable steps on securing entry and rendering the caravans suitable for removal from the land.

Provided that the said Council shall not enter upon any such land unless they have given to the owner and occupier of the land twenty-four hours' notice of their intention to do so, or unless after reasonable inquiries they are unable to ascertain the name and address of such owner and occupier.
