Dear Sirs,

Re Licencing Act 2003 - Objection to current application for licence - Sale of Liquor and provision of music & entertainment at The Assembly Rooms, Town Bridge, Market Place, Boston, Lincolnshire.

I occupy a residential property in close proximity to the above property at [REDACTED] and accordingly advise you that I object most strongly to the proposed opening hours displayed on the notice of licence application as this will have a seriously detrimental effect on my rightful and peaceable occupation of my home.

The reasons I object to this application are as follows...

1. The venue is already in operation since this past weekend and, unlike the previous owners where this was not a problem, while trying to sleep each night we can clearly hear the bass notes from each song and to a level where it is disturbing the peace.
2. This level of sound has been experienced with our windows fully closed [REDACTED]
3. There has been no consultation to our knowledge by the new owners with residents [REDACTED]. If the music continues at the level currently experienced until 3.00 or 4.00 am as proposed within the licence application, then my sleep will be badly impacted.

I should therefore be grateful if you would acknowledge receipt of this objection to the above licence application as it stands and my concerns will be fully taken into account by the licensing committee in terms of proposed hours of operation and permitted noise levels from the installed sound system at the venue.
