

### HER MAJESTY THE QUEENS PLATINUM JUBILEE

#### PROPOSED CELEBRATION BOSTON TOWN CENTRE SUNDAY 5 JUNE 2022

As we are all sure you are aware Her Majesty the Queen will celebrate 70 years as the Monarch. This is one of the most historic dates that this Country will see as no other Monarch as ever reached this milestone and may never be seen again and definitely not in many of our lifetimes.

Arranging Community Events (ACE) feel that this is a date that must be celebrated here in Boston with an event that will put pride back into the town and give everyone a chance to come to together and enjoy a day of fun.

ACE are a small community group of volunteers that got together in 2018 we are fully constituted and have our own bank account. The purpose of our group was to in the hope of putting on local events to raise funds that would be donated to charitable good causes. It did so with a number of events that raised funds for the Mayors Charity. Not only did it succeed in raising a few pound everyone that attended enjoyed the events. Unfortunately we were not able continue with any projects in the last 18 month due to Covid 19.

Many of us will remember the street parties of 1977 for the Silver Jubilee, the events for Golden Jubilee in 2002 and Diamond Jubilee in 2012. ACE feels that the Platinum Jubilee should be marked here in Boston

ACE proposes to have the Market place closed on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2022 to hold celebration event. It is proposed that the vent will have a number of musical acts throughout the day with a range of music for all ages followed by one special headline act to finish off the evening. Alongside these musical acts schools and other community groups will be engaged to put on performances to provide entertainment from the proposed start at 1pm through to 10pm.

Whilst the event will primarily be to celebrate the Jubilee all groups and nationalities would be encouraged to take part to make this a day of celebration for Boston.

The event would centre around the stage in the events area it is proposed to add entertainment all around the edge of the market place, as you will see from the budget that an allowance has been made for children's fairground rides, this is the hire charge for 4 rides that would then be made free to ride for the children for the day. We would also approach face painters etc to come along and provide their services at a reasonable rate as they would be not expected to pay a rent. Local suppliers of sandwiches, cakes, teas and coffees would also be encourage to take a stall to provide refreshment at a reasonable price. Attendees would also be encouraged to bring a picnic.

We want to make the event accessible to all hence the free rides for children and reasonably priced concessions. This will encourage families to come along, have a day's enjoyment without the fear of raiding the piggy bank.

We attach a copy of the budget for the event; these are all backed up by quotes from the most suitable supplier. We appreciate this is a considerable amount of money but want to provide Boston with a premium event that that the town will look back on with pride.

It is hoped that the businesses around the town that will benefit from the event will make a contribution towards the event. We have already approached larger businesses from around the town for sponsorship and have already received encouraging responses.

If we raise more than required by the attached budget we will guarantee that 100% of income will be spent on adding additional items to make the event even bigger and better.

On a final note Boston Borough Council are submitting a bid for City status, if successful this event could then become a joint celebration of the Jubilee and granting of city status with no further event or cost.

We will be more than happy send you regular updates regarding the progress of the event and how the funding is being spent, we would also welcome a representative from your committee join the organising group.
