

## Empowering Healthy Communities Councillor Grant Scheme 2021/22

### Overview of Scheme

£25,683.07 grant money has been awarded to 32 community projects within the Borough.

Through this scheme we have been able to support groups to develop resilience, increase social connection and build stronger relationships in their communities.

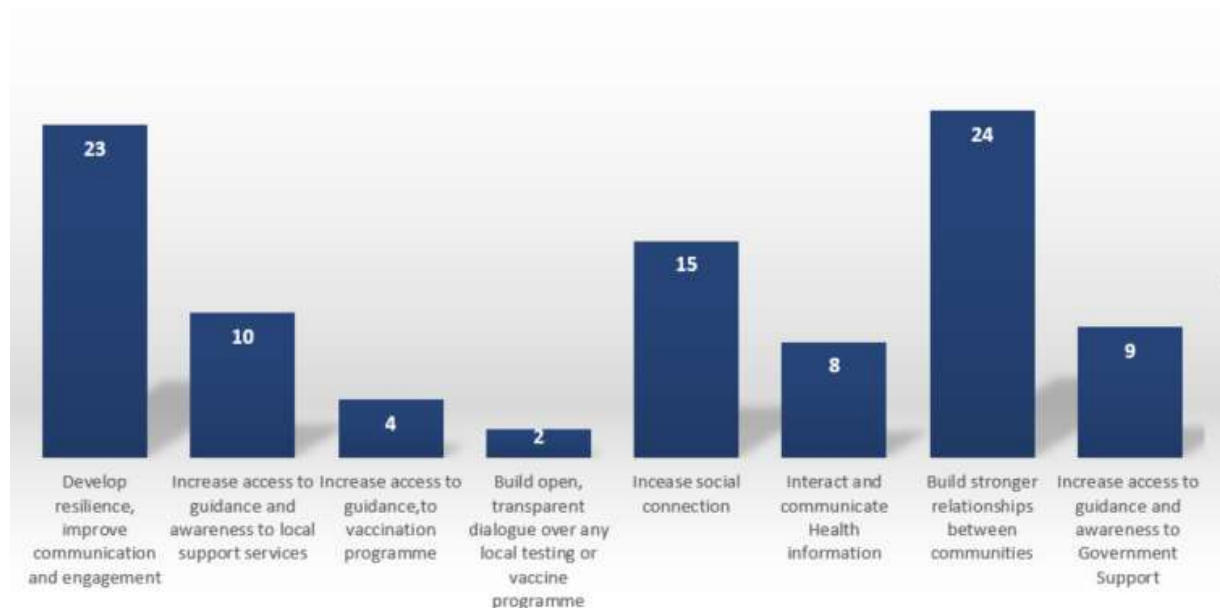
### Outcomes

A number of projects had multiple outcomes, linking to aims within the Empowering Healthy Community Programme:-

- Develop resilience, improve communication and engagement
- Increase access to guidance and awareness to local support services
- Increase access to guidance and awareness to vaccination programme and wider health messages
- Build open, transparent dialogue over any local testing or vaccine programme
- Increase Social Connection
- Interact and communicate Health Information
- Build stronger relationships between communities
- Increase access to guidance and awareness to Government Support
